- The Deacons and Missions Committee recommends hiring Emily Johnson as our Missions Intern for seven weeks beginning June 8, 2025. Her primary role will be connecting international students to the church through one-on-one interaction and group events. She will also work with the Pastor to inventory future mission partnerships inside and outside Pigeon Forge. The Missions Fund will provide her with \$1000.00 weekly compensation. Motion coming from a committee does not require a second; motion passes.

- The Trustees recommend that the church vote on the stewardship of our Wears Valley Property. By marking your ballot YES, you authorize the trustees to proceed with the sale of the Wears Valley property. By marking your ballot NO, you vote not to sell the Wears Valley property at this time.

The floor was open to questions to ascertain the church's heart concerning this property. After some discussion a motion was made by Karen Clabo to postpone the vote for now. The motion declined. Ballots were distributed for the vote; deacons were to count and report the results after the adjournment of the meeting.
