SG Lesson

Let's first summarize the Book of Genesis:

How did it begin? (Then what happened?)

- How did God describe His creation after day 6? (very good)
- What did Adam and Eve do to rebel against God?
- What were the consequences?
- How do we see those consequences today?
- How does God begin to solve our sin problem? (Call of Abraham)
- Tell me what you know of Abraham's Great-Grandson Joseph?
- How does Genesis end?

Tell the Story Read the Story (gets them talking) Rebuild the Story Questions:

1. (Verses 8-14) Why is it a big deal that a new king of Egypt did not know Joseph?

He would not have known the history of how Joseph's God rescued Egypt

2. What were the consequences of not knowing the God of Joseph?

Or: Why did Pharoah fear the Israelites and seek to oppress them?

Worldly fears: distrust, friends becoming enemies, lust for power/control Self-sufficiency

Treating other harsh for your benefit vs. mutual blessings

3. What were the results of persecuting God's people?

Multiplied and spread abroad

4. What can be the result of persecution and martyrdom in the churches today?

Fear and hiding

Or... courage and disciple making

5. (Verses 15-22) What is a tangible evidence that one fears God over man?

It reveals itself in who you obey!

6. What is the result of obeying God over man?

God will deal well with you (man may not, but God will)

7. What kind of people does God use to accomplish His plans/purposes?

 Ordinary people with extraordinary faith, confidence in God, courage to do and stand for what is right!

Sticky Question: Did the midwives lie to Pharoah and still get rewarded by God?

8. Tonight's takeaway: How will you act/react/live if the culture is against you? Who will you choose to fear? How will you prepare yourself to do this?

Begin with word/prayer/share testimony

Saturate yourself with truth (word/song/community)
