Opened with goals:

Bible reading challenge- accountability

Gospel convo testimonies- great time of sharing simplicity of taking opportunities

Shared the story, (read the story in sections according to the questions)

- 1. (Verses 1-10) Why was the child in hiding?
- 2. What do you think was the expected outcome of the baby?
 - Death by gators?
 - Faith that God was going to rescue? (have someone read Hebrew 11:23)
- 3. How did God rescue the baby?
- 4. (Verses 11-15) From this passage, what kind of man was Moses?
 - Protector?
 - Murderer?
- 5. Why did Moses murder the Egyptian? What was his motivation?
 - After they had some time to answer, have them read Acts 7:23-29 and ask if this changes their answer?
- 6. Why did Moses question the motives of the two Hebrews struggling together the very next day?
 - possible answer: Why would you let anger get the best of you two, you are family?
 - If the answers of this reveals more about Moses heart (hypocrisy), consider asking again, "Why did Moses murder the Egyptian? What was his motivation? (See Acts 7:23-29)
- 7. What does this passage say about our "hidden sins"?
 - Someone always knows
- 8. Why was Moses afraid?
 - Not because he sinned, but that he got caught!
- 9. (Verses 16-22) How did Moses' life begin?
 - Rescued by the most prominent family in the world

- 10. What event totally changed his life up to this point?
 - He murdered someone
- 11. What is his life now?
 - See verse 22
 - Sojourner (visitor) in a foreign (unknown) land
- 12. What kind of character do you see in Moses while in the wilderness?
 - Standing up for and saving the women from the shepherds
 - · Watering their flock for them
 - Content to dwell with the Midianite family
- 13. How well do you handle it when life doesn't go the way we planned?
- 14. Where do we see God in this story?
 - Possible answer: not yet (not until verses 23-24)
 - Moses' story is not over, but let's just sit in this moment, a moment we may be experiencing
 - God was preparing Moses for leadership and rescuing His people
 - God humbled Moses to make him a great leader

Tonight's takeaway: What does this passage teach us?

- Doesn't matter where you begin, your decisions can derail you
- Your decisions can be well-meaning, but if sinful, it will have consequences
- How do you handle change of life circumstances?
- Do you trust God is good/sovereign even when He is silent?
- Other?
