Read Exodus 4:1-9

1. What was Moses' hesitation about going back to Egypt according to these verses?

- They would not believe or listen to him

What was God's response to Moses' hesitation?

- God will perform signs to prove Moses' words

What are some ways God has revealed Himself and His power in your life?

Read Exodus 4:10-12

What was Moses' next hesitation?

- Not a good speaker

How did God answer Moses' next hesitation?

- I made you as you are to do what I have called you to do?

How does this speak to us today?

- When God calls us to follow Him, speak for Him, obey Him, He understands our strengths/weaknesses, gifts/deficiencies, skills/handicaps, etc.

Read Exodus 4:13-17

What was the real reason for Moses' hesitation?

- Moses did not want to go

Did God let Moses off the hook? Why? Why not?

- Moses was God's plan

What does God do about our excuses for not following Him?

- God has an answer for everyone of our excuses, and the answer is ultimately "I AM"

What did God provide for Moses?

- Brother, so he would not do it alone

Read Exodus 4:27-31

How does Aaron react to God's commands vs. Moses?

- Obedience

Does this story even hint that Aaron had doubts?

What was the response of the elders to Aaron's speech?

Belief and worship

Takeaway:

God will reveal Himself in a way seekers will not doubt

If God calls you, He will equip you for the task and be responsible for the fulfillment
