

Terms and Policy: VFR Ministry Peer Support Groups

VFR Ministry peer support groups offer spiritual encouragement and community connection. These groups are not medical or clinical in nature, and our facilitators are not licensed psychologists, therapists, counselors, or healthcare providers. Participation in these groups is entirely voluntary and not intended to replace professional psychological, psychiatric, or medical care. If you are in crisis or require clinical support, we strongly encourage you to seek help from a licensed professional.

To help create a safe and respectful space for all group members and participants, we ask that you agree to the following:

- I will keep personal stories and identifying details shared in the group confidential.
- I will not record, screenshot, or share any part of the group session or chat room discussions.
- I will respect the privacy and dignity of others.
- I understand that facilitators may be required to report disclosures of harm or danger.
- I acknowledge that participation is voluntary and that I hold VFR Ministry, its facilitators, and affiliates harmless from any claims, liabilities, or outcomes related to my involvement in these peer support groups.
