I. PREPARATION [:10]

- a. Begin your hour of prayer by praying the Lord's Prayer
 - i. Our Father who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name, thy kingdom come, thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. Forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors. And lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil; for thine is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.
- b. Read Luke 11:1-13
- c. Pray
 - i. Ask the Lord to teach you to pray.
 - ii. Ask the Lord to give you boldness in your prayers.
 - iii. Ask that the promise of Luke 11:10 would be known by you.
 - iv. Ask for faith to believe and receive these truths.
 - v. Ask that the Father would fill you with the Holy Spirit.

Prayer Guide:

Heavenly Father, your Word tells me to boldly ask, seek and knock. I know that you can do all things and that you are able to do immeasurably more than I could ever ask or imagine. I also know that I do not always know how to pray, so please teach me to pray and fill me with your Holy Spirit. I pray that in the next hour you would give me boldness in my asking and increase my faith in believing you hear and answer prayer. I pray this in the name of Jesus, Amen.

II. PRAYER FOR MY CHURCH [:15]

- a. Read Matthew 16:13-20 and Ephesians 5:22-32
- b. Pray
 - i. Ask the Lord to build his church here at Pinewood.
 - ii. Ask the Lord to use his Word to make us holy and blameless, a radiant church without stain, wrinkle or blemish.
 - iii. Ask the Lord to direct us in fulfilling our mission of declaring and demonstrating the gospel so that all people can discover and develop new life in Jesus Christ.

- iv. Ask that God would lead you in how you are to participate in fulfilling this mission and accomplishing his will.
- v. Use the back page of this Guide as a reference for the following prayers.
- vi. Pray for Pastors and their families as they lead, preach, teach and care for us and that God would work and speak through them everyday.
- vii. Pray for our ordained leaders and their families, that God would guide, protect and lead them to do his will.
- viii. Pray our staff and their families that their ministry would be used to bring our children and other young people to saving faith in Jesus Christ.
- ix. Pray for our missionaries and ministries we support that God would use them to seek and save the lost.
- xi. Pray for five families or individuals in our congregation that God places upon your heart at this time that they would be made more like Jesus and that they would give of themselves and their abilities and resources to see God's will accomplished in our church. That they would know the presence and power of God in every aspect of their lives.
- xii. Pray for this hour of prayer and those who will participate. Ask that God would work in the lives of those who participate
- xiii. Pray for our Pave the Way Parking Lot Campaign that God would allow us to rebuild our parking lot.

Prayer Guide:

Father, I ask that your kingdom would come through Pinewood. I pray that through your Word and the power of your Spirit, you would make our congregation faithful and fruitful in our mission, that we would be more like Jesus in our lives. I ask that you would use me to seek the lost, equip the found and transform my home, neighborhood, work or school for the glory of Christ. I pray that you would pour out your Spirit on our leadership as I pray specifically for each by name. I ask that you would use them to lead our church in doing your will. I pray that you would place upon the hearts of our people how they should participate in the fulfillment and advancement of the Kingdom through Pinewood. I pray this in the name of Jesus, Amen.

III. PRAYER FOR THE LOST [:10]

- a. Read Psalm 2 and John 6:35-48
- b. Pray
 - i. Ask that God would fulfill his promise to give the nations to Jesus.
 - ii. Ask that God would draw the lost people within your relationships to himself.
 - iii. Ask that God would give you a heart for these people and that you would be bold in sharing the gospel with others.
 - iv. Ask that God would make it clear in your heart that people outside of Jesus Christ are condemned for all eternity in hell and that although God is sovereign, he commands us to communicate the message of reconciliation through the gospel.
 - v. Ask that God would use you and our church to reach these people with the gospel of Jesus Christ.
 - vi. Ask that the Lord would place upon your heart those you should invite to our church.

Prayer Guide:

Father, you promised to give your Son the nations. Jesus pleaded with you for sinners. He is now at your right hand making intercession. Father you alone can reveal to these people that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of the living God. Father, these people cannot come to you unless you draw them. Holy Spirit, convict them of their sin if they do not trust in Jesus. Grant them repentance; lead them to the knowledge of the truth. Jesus, you came to destroy the work of the devil. Grant that these people come to their senses and are no longer blinded by the god of this age. Renew their hearts so that they come to you in faith and escape the wrath to come. Use me to lead them to yourself. Allow them to see the light of the gospel and receive the bread of life, so that they might know the glory of Jesus and be saved.
