# 3s/4s Lesson Plan - Worship Service

# Sunday, December 7

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: David Sinned and Was Restored - 2 Samuel 11-12; Psalm 51

Instead of going to war with his soldiers like most kings, David, the king of Israel, stayed home. One evening, he saw a lady named Bathsheba. David wanted her to come to his palace even though Bathsheba was married to Uriah.

David knew that taking someone else's wife was wrong. Since Bathsheba was already married, David made an evil plan to hurt her husband, Uriah. He sent Uriah to the front of the battle, where it was dangerous, so Uriah would get hurt. Uriah did get hurt, and he died.

Then David married Bathsheba, and she had a baby. What David did was very wrong, David sinned, and God knew about it.

God sent the prophet Nathan to talk to David. Nathan told David a story. Nathan said, "There was a rich man and a poor man. The rich man had lots of sheep, but the poor man had just one lamb that he loved very much. When the rich man needed a lamb to prepare for a meal, he took the one lamb from the poor man instead of using one of his many sheep."

This story made David very angry at the rich man. Then Nathan said, "You are the rich man in the story! You took something that wasn't yours, and that was wrong."

David felt sorry for his sin. He repented to God, and God forgave him. David wrote a song (Psalm 51) to God to repent for his sin.

**Christ Connection**: When we trust in Jesus and are sorry for our sins, God will forgive us. Jesus died and rose again to rescue us from our sins.

#### Volunteer Huddle | 9:40 a.m.

#### TRANSITION TEAMS

Switch in for the Sunday School volunteer team and receive any information from them if needed. Take over the roster and welcome at the door any new children checking in for the worship service hour.

#### **ACTIVITY PAGES**

Invite children to the tables and pass out the week's Activity Page (in Activity Box) and crayons (in Teacher Box) to each child. After they have finished their pages, they can play freely with toys or books.

During free time, especially because children are at such a young age, please keep a diligent eye and ear on their words and play with one another.

#### PREPARE SNACKS

While children are playing, prepare the snacks. Fill up the pitcher with water and distribute Cheerios in the cups. You don't need to place the snacks on the table yet, just have it ready to go in cups.

**GIVE EXPECTATION:** Give children a *warning* before you ask them to line up.

**SAY** "Everyone, in 5 minutes we are going to pick up our toys and get ready for worship!"

Sing the clean up song and ask children to gather in a line.

### Worship Time | 10:20 am

Have children sit in a circle on the ground. On the **Spotify** app on the TV, pull up the **Preschool Worship Time playlist**.

- For the first three songs, sing and follow the motions of the song: Good Morning God, My God is So Big, If You're Happy and You Know It.
- For the next two songs Jesus is Alive, Jesus Loves Me pull out the instruments from the
  Preschool Worship Time box and allow children to grab them and play and dance along with the
  music.
- For the last song *Jesus Loves Little Children* you can turn off the classroom light, have children put away instruments, sit back down on their mats, and listen quietly to help them calm back down.

### Snack + Lesson Review | 10:40 am

#### Have students sit at the tables for snack time.

- 1. **Pass Out Snacks.** Pass out the water and Cheerios in cups. Double check for any allergies on the classroom tablet.
- 2. **Watch the Bible Lesson Video.** While they eat, you can play the Bible lesson video from the YouTube app on the TV (YouTube account should be <u>Fellowship Kids</u> (switch accounts on the top of the left sidebar if not) > go to <u>Library</u> on the left side bar > Choose <u>Playlists</u> on the top > choose your classroom).

# Lesson Activity | 10:50 am

#### **MAKE A FLUFFY LAMB**

Ask preschoolers to come to the table and distribute a print of a lamb and cotton balls to children (in Activity Box). Set plates of liquid glue on the table (in Activity Box). Demonstrate how to dip the cotton ball in the glue and then stick it to the body of the lamb. Lead children to fill their lamb with cotton balls.

**SAY** You made a cute, fluffy, little lamb. What does a lamb say? Today in our Bible story, the prophet Nathan told David a story about a time when a poor man's only lamb was stolen by a rich man who had many sheep. Nathan told David he was like the rich man because he took something that did not belong to him. David sinned and asked God for forgiveness. God forgave David. When we repent, God forgives us too!

#### **WORSHIP SERVICE TOYS BOX**

Pick up any toys that are currently out in the room and put them back into the Toy Box. Then, take out the **Worship Service Toys box** (toys and activities that only come out at the end of the service) and encourage children to play.
