Sunday, January 11

THIS WEEK'S LESSON: Solomon Thought About Life - Ecclesiastes

Solomon was a rich, famous, wise, and powerful king. In his life, King Solomon learned important things.

He decided to write a book about things he learned and thought about called Ecclesiastes. In the book of Ecclesiastes (ih klee zih AS teez), he wrote that without God, nothing else matters.

King Solomon thought about how people are born, people die, the sun comes up, the sun goes down, the wind blows, and the rivers flow into the sea. Everything is like a big circle that never ends.

He wrote, "You always want more, but nothing ever changes. There is nothing new under the sun."

Solomon wanted everyone to know that nothing we do matters if we don't know God. **The most important thing is to know God and follow Him.**

Christ Connection: *This world won't last forever, but Jesus does. Trusting in Jesus is all that matters. Jesus came to save people from sin so we can be with God forever.*

Volunteer Huddle | 9:40 a.m.

One volunteer should greet children and families at the door.

TRANSITION TEAMS

Switch in for the Sunday School volunteer team and receive any information from them if needed. Take over the roster and welcome at the door any new children checking in for the worship service hour.

ACTIVITY PAGES

Invite children to the tables and pass out the week's **Activity Page** (in Activity Box) and **crayons** (in Teacher Box) to each child. After they have finished their pages, they can play freely with toys or books.

During free time, especially because children are at such a young age, please keep a diligent eye and ear on their words and play with one another.

PREPARE SNACKS

While children are playing, prepare the snacks. Fill up the pitcher with water and distribute Cheerios in the cups. You don't need to place the snacks on the table yet, just have it ready to go in cups.

GIVE EXPECTATION : Give children a **warning** before you ask them to line up.

SAY "Everyone, in 5 minutes we are going to pick up our toys and get ready for worship!"

Sing the clean up song and ask children to gather in a line.

Worship Time | 10:20 am

Have children sit in a circle on the ground. On the **Spotify** app on the TV, pull up the **Preschool Worship Time playlist**.

- For the first three songs, sing and follow the motions of the song: *Good Morning God, My God is So Big, If You're Happy and You Know It*.

- For the next two songs - *Jesus is Alive, Jesus Loves Me* - pull out the instruments from the Preschool Worship Time box and allow children to grab them and play and dance along with the music.
- For the last song - *Jesus Loves Little Children* - you can turn off the classroom light, have children put away instruments, sit back down on their mats, and listen quietly to help them calm back down.

Snack + Lesson Review | 10:40 am

Have students sit at the tables for snack time.

1. **Pass Out Snacks.** Pass out the water and Cheerios in cups. Double check for any allergies on the classroom tablet.
2. **Watch the Bible Lesson Video.** While they eat, you can play the Bible lesson video from the YouTube app on the TV (*YouTube account should be Fellowship Kids (switch accounts on the top of the left sidebar if not) > go to Library on the left side bar > Choose Playlists on the top > choose your classroom).*

Lesson Activity | 10:50 am

“WRITE” A BOOK

Have children sit at the tables and pass out a blank **journal** (in Activity Box) to each child along with crayons. Have children pretend to “write” a book like King Solomon wrote the book of Ecclesiastes. You could prompt them to draw pictures of things they love about God or their favorite things God has made.

SAY *What did you draw in your books? [Allow responses.] King Solomon wrote a book, called Ecclesiastes, to tell everyone about some of the important things he learned. Solomon wanted everyone to know that nothing we do really matters if we don't know God. Solomon taught that God gives life meaning. The things we get in this world don't last forever. Only trusting in Jesus really matters. Jesus came to save people from sin so we can be with God forever.*

Free Play: Special Toys | 11:10 am

WORSHIP SERVICE TOYS BOX

Pick up any toys that are currently out in the room and put them back into the Toy Box. Then, take out the **Worship Service Toys box** (toys and activities that only come out at the end of the service) and encourage children to play. Use this time to engage with children, ask them questions from the lesson, and get to know them better.
