# SAMSON AND THE PHILISTINES

**JUDGES 13-16** 

**CHRIST CONNECTION:** God used Samson to save His people. God sent His Son, Jesus, to save us from our sins and give us life with God forever.

**MEMORY VERSE of the Month:** PHILIPPIANS 4:19 - "And my God will supply every need of yours..." (ESV)

### **Preparation**

#### **Lesson Context**

**This Unit (4 weeks):** Despite Israel's rebellion and attacks from neighboring tribes, God was gracious to raise up judges who would rescue His people from their enemies. While these judges only provided temporary help, they reminded God's people that He would one day provide a perfect Judge to rescue His people from the power of sin.

**SAMSON AND THE PHILISTINES - JUDGES 13-16** 

God's people again did not listen to God. God let the Philistines rule over them.

One day, an angel told a man and woman they were going to have a baby named Samson. He would be strong and save God's people. God had a special rule: never cut Samson's hair.

When he grew up, Samson met a woman named Delilah. She helped the Philistines find out why Samson was so strong.

One night, Delilah told the Philistines to cut Samson's hair, and they cut it. When Samson woke up, he was weak. The Philistines caught and took him away.

When Samson's hair grew back, they took him to a big temple. Samson prayed, and God gave him his strength back. Samson pushed the temple's columns, and it fell. God used Samson to save His people.

#### Volunteer Huddle | 9:40 a.m.

One volunteer should greet children and families at the door.

#### TRANSITION TEAMS

Switch in for the Sunday School volunteer team and receive any information from them if needed. Take over the roster and welcome at the door any new children checking in for the worship service hour.

#### **ACTIVITY PAGES**

Invite children to the tables and pass out the week's Activity Page (in Activity Box) and crayons (in Teacher Box) to each child. After they have finished their pages, they can play freely with toys or books.

During free time, especially because children are at such a young age, please keep a diligent eye and ear on their words and play with one another.

#### PREPARE SNACKS

While children are playing, prepare the snacks. Fill up the pitcher with water and distribute Cheerios in the cups. You don't need to place the snacks on the table yet, just have it ready to go in cups.

**GIVE EXPECTATION:** Give children a *warning* before you ask them to line up.

**SAY** "Everyone, in 5 minutes we are going to pick up our toys and get ready for worship!"

Sing the clean up song and ask children to gather in a line.

## Worship Time | 10:20 am

The preschool worship leader will come in around 10:15 am to prepare the room (move tables and chairs to the edge of the classroom, etc.). The Twos class will come into your room at 10:20 for worship time all together.

The worship leader will lead children through several worship songs. You can help the worship leader by passing out instruments to kids, singing along, and encouraging children to engage with the songs.

### Snack + Lesson Review | 10:40 am

When the other children have left, you can have students sit at the tables for snack time.

- 1. **Pass Out Snacks.** Pass out the water and Cheerios in cups. Double check for any allergies on the classroom tablet.
- 2. **Watch the Bible Lesson Video.** While they eat, you can play the Bible lesson video from the YouTube app on the TV (YouTube account should be <u>Fellowship Kids</u> (switch accounts on the top

of the left sidebar if not) > go to <u>Library</u> on the left side bar > Choose <u>Playlists</u> on the top > choose your classroom).

# Lesson Activity | 10:50 am

#### **SHOW YOUR STRENGTH**

Provide books or other heavy items for toddlers to carry. Clear the playing area and encourage toddlers to walk from one side of the room to the other while carrying the item and doing different actions such as skipping, hopping, jumping over a tape line, and so forth. Monitor closely to ensure safety. Comment on how strong the toddlers are as they play. Review the Bible story.

**SAY** Samson was so strong, what did he do? Yes! He pushed the temple columns, and it fell. God used Samson to save His people. God made Samson strong.

# Free Play: Special Toys | 11:10 am

#### **WORSHIP SERVICE TOYS BOX**

Pick up any toys that are currently out in the room and put them back into the Toy Box. Then, take out the **Worship Service Toys box** (toys and activities that only come out at the end of the service) and encourage children to play. Use this time to engage with children, ask them questions from the lesson, and get to know them better.
