UNIT 9 | SESSION 2

SAMUEL WAS BORN & CALLED

1 SAMUEL 1-3

CHRIST CONNECTION: Samuel heard God's voice and obeyed. Jesus perfectly obeyed God when He came to earth, died on the cross, and rose again to save people from their sin.

MEMORY VERSE of the Month: PHILIPPIANS 4:19 - "And my God will supply every need of yours..." (ESV)

Preparation

Lesson Context

This Unit (4 weeks): Regardless of sin patterns and disobedience, God continued to see His people and hear their requests and desires. God's provision is seen through His gifts of a kinsman redeemer for Ruth's family, a son with a prophetic calling for Hannah, and freedom and protection for the Israelites from the Philistines. God's plan remained steadfast, despite humanity's brokenness.

SAMUEL WAS BORN AND CALLED

Hannah prayed to God for a baby. God heard Hannah's prayers and gave her a baby boy named Samuel.

When Samuel was big enough, Hannah took him to the tabernacle to serve God. Hannah visited Samuel every year and brought him new clothes.

One night while Samuel was sleeping, God called Samuel's name: "Samuel!"

Samuel thought Eli, the priest, was calling for him. God spoke again, "Samuel!"

Eli knew God was speaking to Samuel, so he told Samuel to listen. Samuel said, "Speak, God. I'm listening."

Samuel grew up, and God was with him. Samuel became a special messenger for God in Israel.

Volunteer Huddle | 9:40 a.m.

TRANSITION TEAMS

Switch in for the Sunday School volunteer team and receive any information from them if needed. Take over the roster and welcome at the door any new children checking in for the worship service hour.

ACTIVITY PAGES

Invite children to the tables and pass out the week's Activity Page (in Activity Box) and crayons (in Teacher Box) to each child. After they have finished their pages, they can play freely with toys or books.

During free time, especially because children are at such a young age, please keep a diligent eye and ear on their words and play with one another.

PREPARE SNACKS

While children are playing, prepare the snacks. Fill up the pitcher with water and distribute Cheerios in the cups. You don't need to place the snacks on the table yet, just have it ready to go in cups.

GIVE EXPECTATION: Give children a *warning* before you ask them to line up.

SAY "Everyone, in 5 minutes we are going to pick up our toys and get ready for worship!"

Sing the clean up song and ask children to gather in a line.

Worship Time | 10:20 am

Have children sit in a circle on the ground. On the **Spotify** app on the TV, pull up the **Preschool Worship Time playlist**.

- For the first three songs, sing and follow the motions of the song: Good Morning God, My God is So Big, If You're Happy and You Know It.
- For the next two songs Jesus is Alive, Jesus Loves Me pull out the instruments from the Preschool Worship Time box and allow children to grab them and play and dance along with the music
- For the last song *Jesus Loves Little Children* you can turn off the classroom light, have children put away instruments, sit back down on their mats, and listen quietly to help them calm back down.

Snack + Lesson Review | 10:40 am

When the other children have left, you can have students sit at the tables for snack time.

- 1. **Pass Out Snacks.** Pass out the water and Cheerios in cups. Double check for any allergies on the classroom tablet.
- 2. **Watch the Bible Lesson Video.** While they eat, you can play the Bible lesson video from the YouTube app on the TV (YouTube account should be <u>Fellowship Kids</u> (switch accounts on the top

of the left sidebar if not) > go to <u>Library</u> on the left side bar > Choose <u>Playlists</u> on the top > choose your classroom).

Lesson Activity | 10:50 am

WHISPER MESSAGES

Invite children to form a circle on the ground. Say to the children that you want to test how good their hearing is. Tell them that you are going to whisper several messages. They need to listen carefully and repeat the messages back to you. Whisper statements such as "God loves you," "God gives you what you need," "Jesus helps us," or "God answers prayers."

SAY You did a good job listening! Today we heard a story about how God whispered to a little boy named Samuel. Samuel learned to listen to God's Word!

Free Play: Special Toys | 11:10 am

WORSHIP SERVICE TOYS BOX

Pick up any toys that are currently out in the room and put them back into the Toy Box. Then, take out the **Worship Service Toys box** (toys and activities that only come out at the end of the service) and encourage children to play. Use this time to engage with children, ask them questions from the lesson, and get to know them better.
