THIS WEEK'S LESSON: Saul Rescued Israel - 1 Samuel 11-13

Some of the friends of God's people needed help. They sent messages saying, "Help us!"

So, King Saul gathered a big army. Saul's army won! Everyone was happy, but Samuel was worried.

Samuel warned God's people, "If you listen to God and do what is right, everything will be OK. But if you disobey, you and the king will be swept away."

One day, the Philistines wanted to fight Israel. Instead of waiting for Samuel to ask God for help, Saul offered a sacrifice, which only Samuel was allowed to do. Saul prepared for battle anyway. Saul didn't wait

When Samuel found out, Samuel told Saul, "You made a wrong choice. God wants people who will listen to Him. Now, He has chosen someone else to be king."

Christ Connection: Jesus is the King who always obeyed God. When we trust in Jesus, He saves us from sin and death and gives us life with God forever.

Volunteer Huddle | 9:40 a.m.

Grab your nametag at the check-in desk and then meet in the room (Room #126) to the left of the desk for prayer and important info for this Sunday. If possible, please wear your Fellowship Church t-shirt or Fellowship hoodie.

Enter and Prep Room | 9:50 a.m.

- Prep room for any activities you will do during the lesson.
- Fill up the pitcher in the Teacher Box (yellow lid) with water so that it is ready for snack time.

Transition & Free Play | 9:45 - 10:15 am

One volunteer should greet children and families at the door.

TRANSITION TEAMS

Switch in for the Sunday School volunteer team and receive any information from them if needed. Take over the roster and welcome at the door any new children checking in for the worship service hour.

FREE PLAY

Children can play freely until 10:15 am. Use this time to ask them questions about their week and get to know them. During free time, especially because children are at such a young age, please keep a diligent eye and ear on their words and play with one another.

PREPARE SNACKS

While children are playing, prepare the snacks. Fill up the pitcher with water and distribute Cheerios in the cups. You don't need to place the snacks on the table yet, just have it ready to go in cups.

GIVE EXPECTATION: Give children a *warning* before you ask them to line up.

SAY "Everyone, in 5 minutes we are going to pick up our toys and line up to head to worship!"

Sing the clean up song and ask children to gather in a line.

Worship Time | 10:20 am

Have children sit in a circle on the ground. On the **Spotify** app on the TV, pull up the **Preschool Worship Time playlist**.

- For the first three songs, sing and follow the motions of the song: Good Morning God, My God is So Big, If You're Happy and You Know It.
- For the next two songs Jesus is Alive, Jesus Loves Me pull out the instruments from the
 Preschool Worship Time box and allow children to grab them and play and dance along with the
 music.

• For the last song - Jesus Loves Little Children - you can turn off the classroom light, have children put away instruments, sit back down on their mats, and listen quietly to help them calm back down.

Snack | 10:40 am

Have students sit at the tables for snack time.

- 1. **Pass Out Snacks.** Pass out the water and Cheerios in cups. Double check for any allergies on the classroom tablet.
- 2. **Watch the Bible Lesson Video.** While they eat, you can play the Bible lesson video from the YouTube app on the TV (YouTube account should be <u>Fellowship Kids</u> (switch accounts on the top of the left sidebar if not) > go to <u>Library</u> on the left side bar > Choose <u>Playlists</u> on the top > choose your classroom).

After the video, you can pull out the coloring pages (in Activity Box) if children would like to color at the tables.

Lesson Activity | 10:50 am

FOLLOW THE LEADER

Invite preschoolers to watch and follow you. If space is limited, do actions such as clapping, patting your head, wiggling your fingers, or making silly faces. If you have more room, consider actions such as hopping, tiptoeing, or dancing around the room. Play additional rounds of the game. Choose a preschooler to be the leader and encourage the other children to follow him.

SAY You did a great job following and obeying my directions. Saul was a great warrior but chose to disobey God. He made an offering to God even though he was not supposed to. Samuel told Saul that he had made a wrong choice, and that God had chosen someone else to be the king. God wanted someone who would listen to Him. Saul was a good king sometimes, but he disobeyed God. Jesus always obeyed God. Jesus saves us from our sin and gives us life with God forever.

Free Play: Special Toys | 11:00 am

WORSHIP SERVICE TOYS BOX
