## SOAP JOURNAL COMPANION

This guide is a companion for your **SOAP Journal** to offer optional Scriptures to use in your daily Jesus time.

### What is SOAP?

**Scripture:** Read something in the Bible. Write in your journal the address where the scripture reference is found.

**Observation:** Write or draw in your journal what happened in the story. Who's talking? What are they saying? What did they do? This can be as short or long as you like.

**Application:** Ask how this Scripture applies to your life. Does anything stick out to you? Is it talking about something you should do or change? Write or draw in your journal about your life.

**Prayer:** Talk and listen to God about Scripture you've read, other things in your life, or whatever's on your mind. Then give God time to speak to your heart. Journal your prayers and God's answers.

### One way to PRAY From Matt 6:9-13

**Praise** God for who He is and what He's done. "Our Father in Heaven, may Your name be honored."

**Repent** of sins I've done and commands I have not done. "And forgive us our sins, just as we also have forgiven those who sin against us."

**Ask** for the needs of others and myself. "Give us today our daily bread. Keep us from sinning when we are tempted."

**Yield** what I want so I can do what God wants instead. "May Your kingdom come. May what You want to happen be done on earth as it is done in heaven."
