What is the chief end of man?

What is God?

God is a Spirit - infinite, eternal, and unchangeable, in his being, wisdom, power, holiness, justice, goodness, and truth.

Are there more Gods than one? There is only one, the living and true God.

How many persons are there in the Godhead?

There are three persons in the Godhead:
 the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit;
and these three are one God, the same in substance,
 equal in power and glory.

SCRIPTURE OF EXHORTATION

Galatians 5:16-24

But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh. For the desires of the flesh are against the Spirit, and the desires of the Spirit are against the flesh, for these are opposed to each other, to keep you from doing the things you want to do. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are evident: sexual immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmity, strife, jealousy, fits of anger, rivalries, dissensions, divisions, envy, drunkenness, orgies, and things like these. I warn you, as I warned you before, that those who do such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. And those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires.

Cast me not away from your presence, and take not your Holy Spirit from me.


Restore to me the joy of your salvation, and uphold me with a willing spirit.

Join us today in the Fellowship Hall during the Sunday School hour to hear how you can get connected through our various ministries at FPC!




Construction has begun on our parking lot. We will use the Harts' parking lot and the Grand parking lot while ours is under construction. On Wednesdays, only Harts' will be available.
