Psalm 6:6 “I am weary with my moaning; every night I flood my bed with tears; I drench my couch with my weeping.”

Psalm 86:5 “For you, O Lord, are good and forgiving, abounding in steadfast love to all who call upon you.”

Psalm 103:10”He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities.”

- Your mercies are new every morning and you are merciful to me not holding my sins against me. Rather, you have taken them onto yourself on the Cross of Calvary.
- Thank you Father that you do not deal with me according to my sin but according to your Righteousness!

Psalm 119:59 “When I think on my ways, I turn my feet to your testimonies;”

- My testimony is in your Lord Jesus! My ways are turned toward your loving kindness.

Psalm 130:3 “If you, O Lord, should mark iniquities, O Lord, who could stand?”

- Thank you Jesus that my sins are gone as far as the East is from the West! Never to be remembered against me anymore.

Psalm 130:4 “But with you there is forgiveness, that you may be feared.”

Psalm 143:2 “Enter not into judgment with your servant, for no one living is righteous before you.”
