Awanita 2025: God Moved in a Powerful Way

What an incredible weekend our JI Youth had at Awanita Valley! This year's fall retreat was nothing short of amazing. God's presence was evident from the moment we arrived until the moment we loaded the bus to head home.

We took a total of <u>48 students</u>, which is the largest group we have ever brought to Awanita. We also want to celebrate and thank our incredible volunteers who served faithfully all weekend. Their sacrifice, patience, joy, and willingness to invest in students made every moment possible. A special celebration goes to our first ever JI Youth alumni volunteer. Sara, who graduated from our youth group, joined us for her very first retreat as a leader and absolutely crushed it. We love leader Sara and are so grateful for the way she served our students with such heart and maturity. From leading small groups, to praying with students, to hiking mountains and keeping up with middle school boy energy, our volunteers were the backbone of this retreat.


