Sunday School

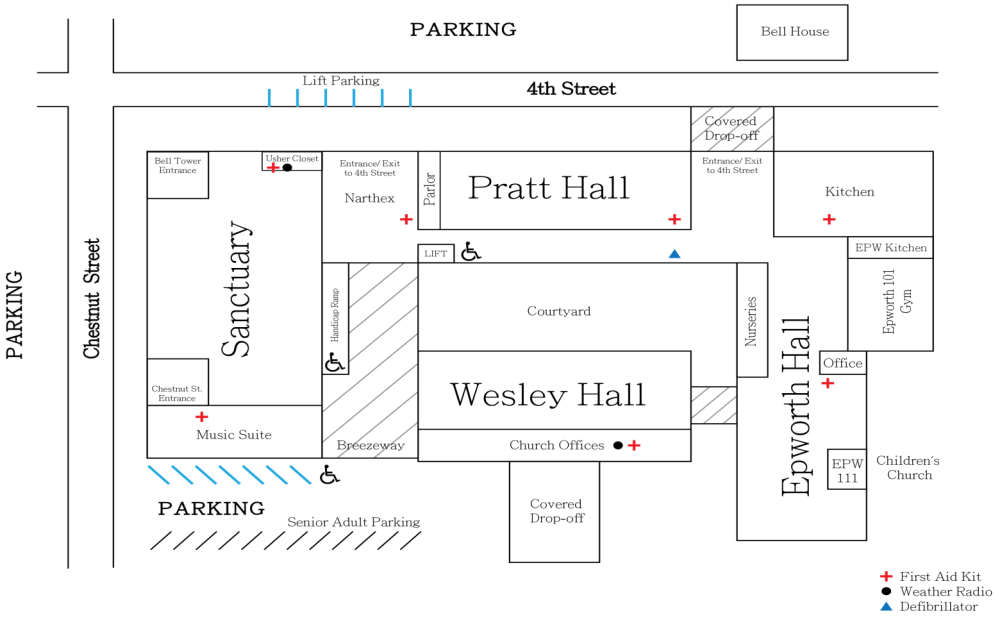

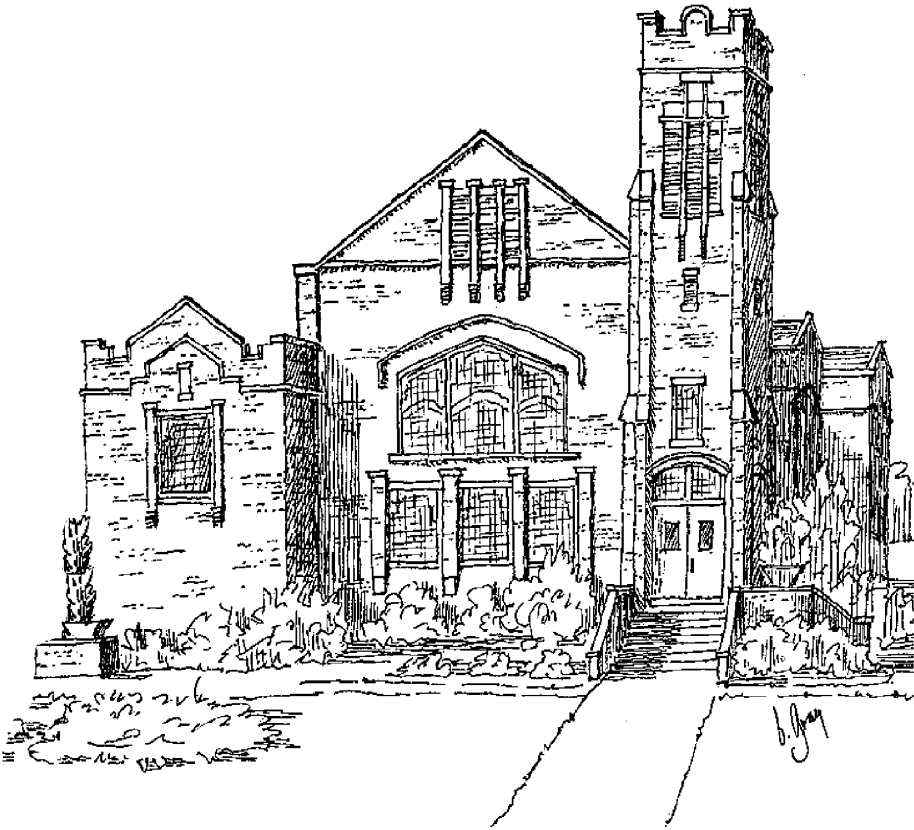
