Sunday School

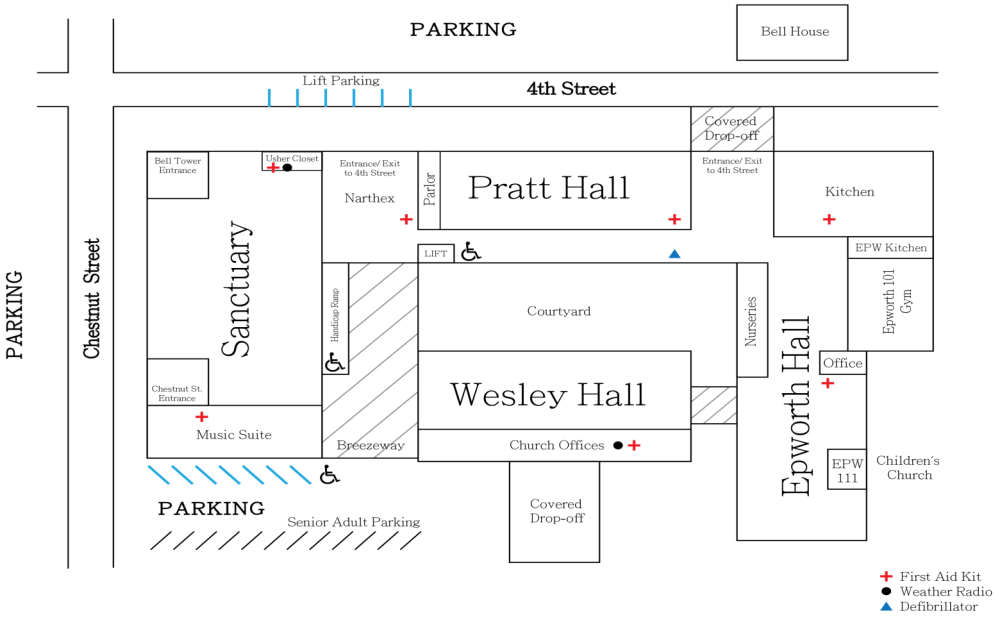
