Sunday School

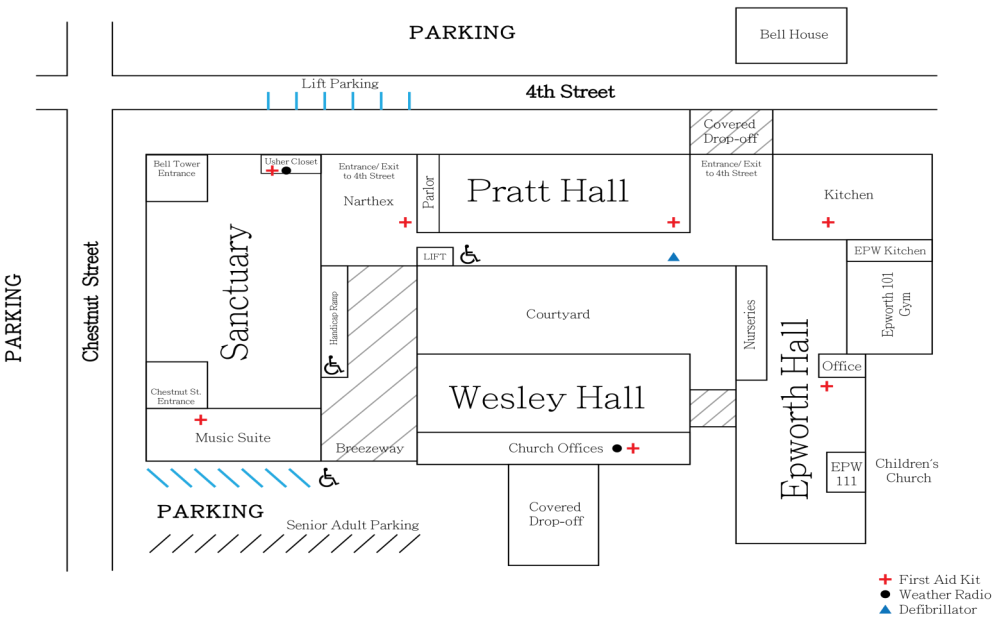

Interested? Come learn the facts about the Holy Land Tour planned for Oct. 2026.

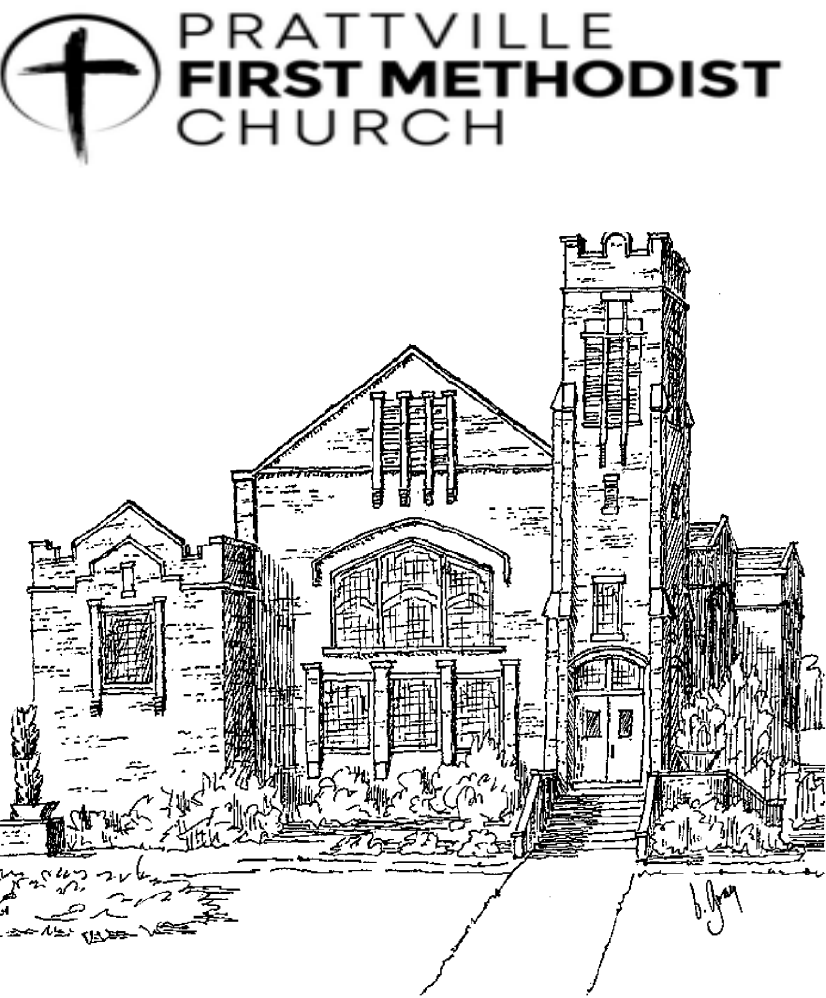
**Summer Lunch & Learn, part 2 - with Pastor Larry, this Wed., July 16th**
