From Your Associate Pastor of Youth & Families

<u>Joy Class</u> are men and women of all ages and meet in Room 7/9. this group also studies the Bible using the Explore the Bible series.


Fishers of Men are adult men and women of all ages. They meet in the Fellowship Hall.

All women and teenage girls are invited.


Our March meeting will be held on Sunday, September 14, 2025 and will meet in the church Fellowship Hall at 2:00 pm.
