4. If the Holy Spirit was a seatbelt light on a plane, how often would He be turning it on in your life?
5. Can you think of a time when God showed you how you got to a place you didn't belong?
6. Which seat do you naturally gravitate toward—front row eager, middle row comfortable, or back row distracted?
7. What influences, habits, or people tend to "keep you seated" in the wrong places?
8. Would your "seat of influence" be more like a throne, a folding chair, or a beanbag right now?
9. What helps you delight in God's Word and keep it at the center of your life?
10. If you could swap seats with anyone for a day (spiritually or literally), who would it be and why?
