5. What does it mean to you that God doesn't call the qualified, but qualifies the called?
6. Have you ever tried to help God out, only to make the situation messier?
7. How have you experienced God's presence or covenant faithfulness in your own life?
8. If your faith journey was a road trip, what kind of car would you be driving?
9. Why is obedience such a critical part of being commissioned by God, even when it costs us?
10. If Abraham's story was turned into a modern movie, who would play him—and who would play the ram?
