

Subject: Faith is the Key

Last week we studied some of the names of God. This week we are going to focus on having faith when you call His names. There is only one God. Each names do not suggests that there are multiple Gods. Remember, if you know someone's name usually you have a relationship with them. Don't just call God by His name, but call Him by his name mixed with FAITH...The Greek word for faith is **PISTIS**, please look up and become familiar with this word...

○ Read the scriptures below, and focus on the word **faith...pistis(greek)**

Heb 4:1 Let us therefore fear, lest, a promise being left us of entering into his rest, any of you should seem to come short of it.

Heb 4:2 For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with **faith** in them that heard it.

Heb 11:4 By **faith** Abel offered unto God a more excellent sacrifice than Cain, by which he obtained witness that he was righteous, God testifying of his gifts: and by it he being dead yet speaketh.

Heb 11:5 By **faith** Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

Heb 11:6 But without **faith** it is impossible to please him: for he that cometh to God must **believe** that he is, and that he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Read the scriptures that associated with the name of God to become familiar with why God was called that particular at that moment. Maybe you can call God by that name in your time of need...
