TIME to Bless and Invest | Additional Questions

- Based on the Mark 2:15-17 reading and the Luke 19:1-10 reading:
 - Can you imagine your ONE having similar interests in Jesus as Zaccheus did? If so, how does that challenge or inspire you to spend time with your ONE?
 - How can something as simple as eating a meal together be an opportunity to join God in His work?
- Scan last week's calendar. Where could you have *shared* existing time with your ONE (meals, kids' sports, errands, exercise)?
- Of the specific things you can do with your ONE you listed in the book, choose one. Pray with your group about it and then contact your ONE this week and schedule it.
- Pray: "Lord, interrupt my routine this week for a holy appointment." Do you expect God to answer this prayer? How can you be ready to respond to His answer?
- Between distraction, busyness and agitation, which of these three tends to get in the way of building relationships with ONEs for you most and why?
- Take time to pray for one another as you each surrender your distractions, busyness and agitations to God.
