The central theme revolves around Jesus' teachings in Luke 14, where He speaks about the cost of discipleship. We're reminded that following Christ isn't just about believing, but about giving up everything for Him. This radical call pushes us to consider: Are we truly living as disciples, or merely calling ourselves Christians? The message draws parallels between building our faith and constructing a tower, emphasizing the importance of counting the cost before we begin. It's a sobering reminder that our spiritual journey requires continuous effort and dedication. We're encouraged to 'build ourselves up in our most holy faith' as mentioned in Jude, highlighting our personal responsibility in spiritual growth. This message urges us to move beyond spiritual infancy, to develop a faith that's active, growing, and transformative in our daily lives.
