## From the Branches Family, To Our Friends and Guests

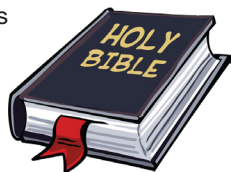

Bring a food item to share, drinks provided. And we are starting on time so the guest speaker can share as we are eating.

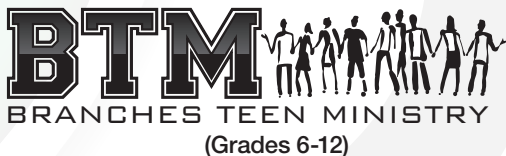

On Wednesdays childcare is provided for Infants to 1st Grade at this time.



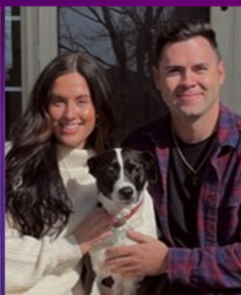
