From the Branches Family, To Our Friends and Guests

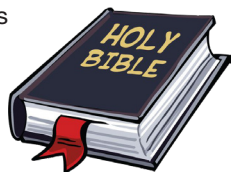

Gen Next Cookout & Field Day – 9/21

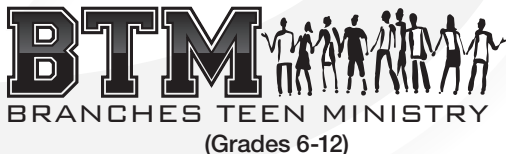
