 - a. The concept of a "royal court" in heaven (1 Kings 22; Jeremiah 23:16-18; Amos 3:7-8; Malachi 3:1)
 - b. "Thus says Yahweh"
 - c. Example: Isaiah 6:1-9
 - d. The Prophetic (or Covenant) Lawsuit
 - i. The prophet is the legal representative of the Great King
 - ii. Isaiah 1:18: "Come now, and let us reason together,' says [Yahweh]. Though your sins are as scarlet, they will be as white as snow."
