From the Message:

- 1) Does it seem unfair to you that God promised Abraham and Sarah a child and then made them wait 25 years before that child was born? Why or Why not?
- 2) How can remembering who we are waiting on influence our attitudes in the waiting.
- 3) Share about what God is doing in your life right now. How does that encourage you in the areas you are still waiting for Him?
- 4) How can you defend against the urge to take things into your own hands as you wait for God?

Discuss from the readings:

James uses three words for patience in this passage. The first is in 7,8 and means, 'To look with anticipation" or " to wait expectantly." The second is in verse 10 and means, "to take a long time to get heated." The third is in verse 11, and means, "to remain up under a pressure." In light of these definitions, discuss the following:

- 1) When do you find it hardest to be patient?
- 2) How can God's faithfulness in the past help us be patient with our present situation?
- 3) In thinking about stubborn people, why do we struggle with their unwillingness to change?
- 4) How does our impatience hurt the relationship?
- 5) Discuss how Job was able to remain patient even when he couldn't understand what God was doing.
- 6) What can we learn from Job in relation to something we don't understand?
