The Gift of Grace

If you remember from last month, I shared about the first five verses of Ephesians 2. There we learned about how we have all failed to live up to God's standards and were part of the kingdom of darkness and, therefore, were fighting against God. Yet. God saved us through His Son, Jesus Christ because He is a gracious and merciful God. It wasn't because we were good enough or deserved it. He saved us because He loves us. But God didn't only save us through Jesus, but actually elevated us and recreated us to be His prized

handiwork. Ephesians 2:6-10 (ESV) reads.

"And raised us up with him and seated us with him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the coming ages he might show the immeasurable riches of his grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith. And this is not your own doing; it is the gift of God, not a result of works, so that no one may boast. For we are his workmanship, created in Christ Jesus for good works, which God prepared beforehand, that we should walk in them."

This Scripture tells us that on a spiritual level all who believe in Jesus are seated with Him in the heavenly places where He currently reigns and rules. God has raised us far above our station, further than we could have ever imagined, considering how we treated Him and turned away from Him before He saved us. We get to share in Christ's reign that He alone earned and deserves. It reminds us that our place in Christ isn't ours by our own effort, but His alone. He has graciously given it to us. Yet this doesn't mean we don't have something to do. God has actually prepared for us in Christ, good works to do and we are to walk in them. Yet we always do good works because of the gracious goodness of God, not because we are trying to earn God's favor. We already have it. Let us walk in the grace of God and do the good works He has prepared for us.

In the Grip of Grace by Max Lucado


