This semester at SDSU, Cru has been a very exciting, hope filled time. At the beginning of the semester we challenged 15 freshmen to be a part of a freshmen leadership team. Each week we have lunch with this group, get to know each other, and do some training and equipping for them to go out and bring the gospel to their campus.

They are also each a part of one of 4 teams: outreach, prayer, worship, and community teams. Each has been in charge of planning activities for the larger Cru group. This week we are starting the outreach that the outreach team planned. They are calling it Digits for Donuts! The idea is that we will have posters and set up a table in the union where we will engage students and ask them if they have any guestions about spiritual things.

Then if they submit a question, next week the leaders will reach out and set a time to meet with them, answer their question as best they can and give them a donut for participating! I am really excited to see these leaders step out in faith and I hope they get to have a bunch of great spiritual conversations that could lead to gospel conversations and potentially new believers!
