PERSONAL STUDY QUESTIONS #2 - "THE GOLDEN LAMPSTAND"

May you cultivate a constant awareness of GOD, by looking always to the light of the world, JESUS. Who has called us as HIS followers to shine as a light for HIM in this dark world.

1. What was the lampstand made of? Who was commanded by GOD to light the golden lampstand in the Tabernacle to keep it continually lit? Why was this to be done? Leviticus 24:3-4.

3. In Exodus 25:31-34, it speaks of the Golden Lampstand being designed with ornamental (carved) branches, knobs, flowers and bowls with almond blossoms. Why is the almond design so significant? (see also Numbers 17)

4. What did the Lord declare in 1 John 1:5? Who doesn't have fellowship with Him? Check verse 6.

5. How do we know that we have fellowship with one another? 1 John 1:7

6. As the Lord's people, what has HE told us that we are? Matthew 5:14-15. And what is our responsibility? Verse 16.

7. Although we live in a very dark world, how should we reflect the Lord as lights in this world? Philippians 2:15b

8. Psalm 89:15 tells us how the people of GOD are when what happens?

9. What does Revelation 2:4-5 tell us regarding those who don't choose to live a life that shines for God?
