6. It's been said, "Why should I pray if God already knows the outcome?" Luke 18:1-7

7. Read Mark 7:24-30. What was Jesus trying to "draw out from this Gentile woman?
8. What promise is given to us in James 4:8? How does this apply when we pray.
9. What can help you be aware of God's presence everyday? Psalm 55:17.
10. Personal: In a time of crisis, are you more prone to run to the phone, or go to the throne? How you answer this question, is usually a good indicator where you as a believer are "dwelling."
