Dear Dr. Thomas and Shiloh Church Family,

Thank you so much for thinking of us, the family of Elder Joseph and Mrs. Carolyn Hinson, as you have planned the 37th Church Anniversary Celebration for Shiloh. You may be sure that the Hinson family will be represented on that Sabbath.

Your theme, "A People, A Place, A Purpose: 37 Years of Faithful Mission in Smyrna," is so very appropriate. The Shiloh Church has always been a place with a purpose of faithful mission. It has held its doors open to all; it has nurtured so many families and has given them a place to regroup and reflect and grow; it has encouraged so many young people to find God's calling in their hearts and to seek His ways in their lives—and they have done just that.

As for Daddy and Mom, the Shiloh Church was one of the last congregations in their ministry. It was their joy to serve. Nothing stopped Daddy from making pastoral visits; nurturing parents and children; young and old; calling and attending church board and business meetings, and also always encouraging faithful giving and fundraising when needed, starting with his own finances.

These activities came to a surprising pause with Elder Hinson's heart attack and quadruple bypass surgery just at the start of the 1996 Olympics in Atlanta. His surgery was performed at the Crawford Long Hospital, exactly where Olympic athletes were treated! God took care of him, and took care of us. He was able to recover to the point of standing in the Shiloh pulpit to preach his final sermons before his retirement. Though his life was not the same, and though the "peace and quiet" in his life took a time of adjustment, he did come to enjoy many aspects of his retirement years until his passing in 2004.

Mrs. Carolyn Hinson remained a faithful Shiloh member for years herself, serving in various offices and capacities; also nurturing members of all ages. She returned for many special occasions to share fellowship and joy. An Alzheimer's Disease diagnosis took her gradually, but didn't take her personality or love for conversation until almost the final days before her passing in 2022.

As their children, Kyna, Lisa, Marla and Walter Fordham III, and grandchildren Selah and Logan Fordham, we will miss them always. We eagerly await the glorious day when Jesus will return, to bring more fellowship and joy, and to reunite us all. May God keep all of us and Shiloh in His love and care forever.



Shiloh Church History

Shiloh Seventh-day Adventist Church is the first Black Adventist church in Cobb County, Georgia. It was established through the vision of Pastor Joseph Hinson. He was concerned about the young people in the Lemon Street area of Marietta. With the help of Mr. James Ellerbe and Dr. Gary Ashford, he conducted a youth empowerment meeting in 1988 and another one in 1989. From the meetings, twenty people were baptized and Shiloh Seventh-day Adventist Church was born.



At first, Shiloh worshipped at 264 Fowler Circle in Marietta, Georgia. In 1993, the worship location was changed to Harvest Time Fellowship Church in Smyrna, Georgia. On March 17, 1997, Shiloh purchased Harvest Time Fellowship Church which is currently our church home at 810 Church Street, Smyrna, Georgia.

Shiloh's membership grew and more demand for space became evident. Plans were made to expand the sanctuary and add to the building. In 2000, the Hinson Family Life Center was erected and on April 21, 2001 the first service was held in the renovated sanctuary. Shiloh's youth quickly took advantage of the gym in the Hinson Family Life Center to host basketball games and other activities. Sabbath lunches became regular fellowship opportunities. The mortgage used to finance the building and renovation project was paid off in approximately ten years. A Mortgage Burning celebration was held to commemorate the occasion.

As Shiloh grew, a small group started a branch Sabbath School in Kennesaw, Georgia. Thirty-six individual from Shiloh branched off and became the charter members of the Mount Pisgah Company which is located at 1210 Wooten Lake Road, Kennesaw. On September 15, 2007, Mount Pisgah became an independent company. Ten years later, on September 22, 2017, Mount Pisgah purchased its own church building at 2751 South Main St, Kennesaw, Georgia. Mount Pisgah membership has grown from 36 members to over 100 members Shiloh and Mount Pisgah maintain a close relationship.

Shiloh has also grown significantly. Each Sabbath, members, frequent guests and visitors worship together. Shiloh has grown from the original twenty members to over 400 members. To God be the glory!
