







September 2023 Keep Praying - Part II

"Ask, and it will be given you; seek, and you will find; knock, and it shall be opened to you: For every one who asks receives; and he who seeks finds; and to him who knocks it shall be opened." (Matthew 7:7, 8 NKJV). The Lord's Prayer says, "Our Father, which art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name." Then it continues: "Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven" (Matthew 6:9,10 KJV). Now, hold on. Matthew 7:7 says that if we need something, we should just ask. That everyone who asks receives? But the Lord's Prayer seems to tell us that it doesn't matter what we ask; God will do what He wants.

Thus, like a father who promises his son that he'll give him whatever he wants for his birthday, the son asks for a bicycle, but instead, his father gives him a math book. Of course, in the long run, the math book will be beneficial to the boy, but he will be very disappointed on his birthday. So, back to the question: If God hears what I ask for but instead gives me what he thinks is best, then why ask? That's how we feel sometimes. The boy's problem isn't the math book; it's a good math book.


