May 15, Friday

You are responsible for making your own airline reservations to Israel. Make plans to arrive in Tel Aviv no later than 5 P.M on Saturday.

May 16, Saturday

You will be met in the airport Welcome Hall and taken to our hotel. After dinner, we will have a meet-and-greet orientation stroll on the shore of the Mediterranean Sea before returning to the hotel for good night of rest.

May 17, Sunday

There are surprises to experience every day. They begin on the road to Beer Sheva, where we will spend the night. Heading south into the Negev, from the 21st Century to the days of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob, our first stop is where David defeated Goliath. Next up is an active archeological site where you will participate in the digging, touching pottery that has not been seen for 2,200 years!



May 18, Monday

The day begins at Tel Sheva, in the heart of the Negev. This region was home to the Patriarchs of the Jewish people. Moving eastward towards the Dead Sea you will get a taste of what Israel experienced during 40 years of wilderness wandering. You will ride camels, have coffee and a meal in a Bedouin tent, and marvel at the sight of desert stars.

May 19, Tuesday

Today's highlight is Masada, the last stronghold of Jewish resistance to Rome after Jerusalem's destruction in 70 A.D. The nature preserve at En Gedi is where David spared the life of King Saul. A gigantic waterfall is the reward of an exhilarating one mile hike. Qumran, where the Dead Sea scrolls were discovered and a Dead Sea "swim" are also on the schedule. Tonight we reside at a kibbutz near the place Gideon launched his night-time attack on the Midianites.

May 20, Wednesday

This morning we begin our exploration of the life and times of Messiah Jesus at Bet Shean. Across the Jezreel Valley, Nazareth Village provides a unique look into the 1st Century community Jesus would have known. Lunch today is part of your package. God willing, your first view of the Sea of Galilee will be from Mt. Arbel, followed by a visit to a recent discovery at the hometown of Mary Magdalene. The next two mornings you will wake up to the sun rising over the Golan Heights!

May 21, Thursday

The people living around the Sea of Galilee witnessed seventy-five percent of the miracles Jesus performed. They heard about the amazing things He said and wondered, "who is this that speaks with such authority?" Today we will visit places where many signs and wonders validated the messianic claims of Yeshua, the Son of David. One of the highlights of our day is a boat ride on the lake where Jesus calmed the wind and waves by the power of His words.



May 22, Friday

Traveling north through the Upper Jordan Valley, the first stop of the day is Tel Dan. Here, Jeroboam reinstituted the worship of the golden calf at the beginning of the

Divided Kingdom period. Nearby Caesarea Philippi is where Peter answered the question "Who do you say that I am?" Both sites are on Israel's northern border with Lebanon and Syria in the Golan Heights. This afternoon you will see for yourself why the Golan Heights are so crucial to the security of the State of Israel. The final stop of the day is the Talmudic Center in Katzrin for a personal exploration of the conflict between Jesus and the religious elites.

May 23, Saturday

Today we go up to Jerusalem! Along the way, we will stop at Megiddo, the location of a last days event. Your afternoon arrival in Jerusalem provides a first look at the City of the Great King from the Mt. of Olives. Lord willing, we will ascend the mountain from Bethphage and walk down to the Kidron Valley and the Garden of Gethsemane. For the next four nights, we will reside inside the walls of the Jewish Quarter, in the heart of Jerusalem.

May 24, Sunday

Our time in Jerusalem is packed with essential experiences. Every person who visits Israel needs to stare directly into the face of the demonic evil perpetrated on the Jewish people throughout history. Yad Vashem, the national memorial of the Holocaust, is the first stop of the day, followed by the Model City, and the Shrine of Book. Bethlehem, with the Church of the Nativity and Shepherd's Fields, is scheduled for the afternoon. This will be a very full and emotional day.

May 25, Monday

The best way to see the Old City is on foot. There will be a lot of walking today. Our



stops include the City of David, Hezekiah's Tunnel, the Pool of Siloam, and the base of the Temple Mount, and the Kotel (Western Wall). The Western Wall tunnels are on the schedule. This afternoon you have some time to shop in the souk before returning to the hotel for dinner. Tonight, you will have the rare privilege of hearing what it is like to serve the Lord as a pastor in Israel.

May 26, Tuesday

Lord willing, our last full day in Jerusalem will begin with a visit to the platform of the Temple Mount. Throughout the remainder of the day, we will retrace the final day of Jesus' life from the traditional site of Caiaphas' house, to Pontius Pilate's headquarters, to Golgotha and the grave. The last stop of the day is the Garden Tomb. This location provides an opportunity to see what the burial site of Jesus may have appeared like 2,000 years ago. Could this have been the place?

May 27, Wednesday

We depart Jerusalem early, headed for Caesarea Maritime, where Paul was imprisoned for two years before being sent to Rome. En-route we will make a stop at Shiloh. The last stop of this Bible adventure is Jaffa. During a final meal together we will reflect on our journey and and give voice to how we will share this experience with others where God has strategically placed you. After dinner, we will head to the airport and catch overnight flights to the United States.

May 28, Thursday

Arrive home to tell your story about what God taught you on this trip.
