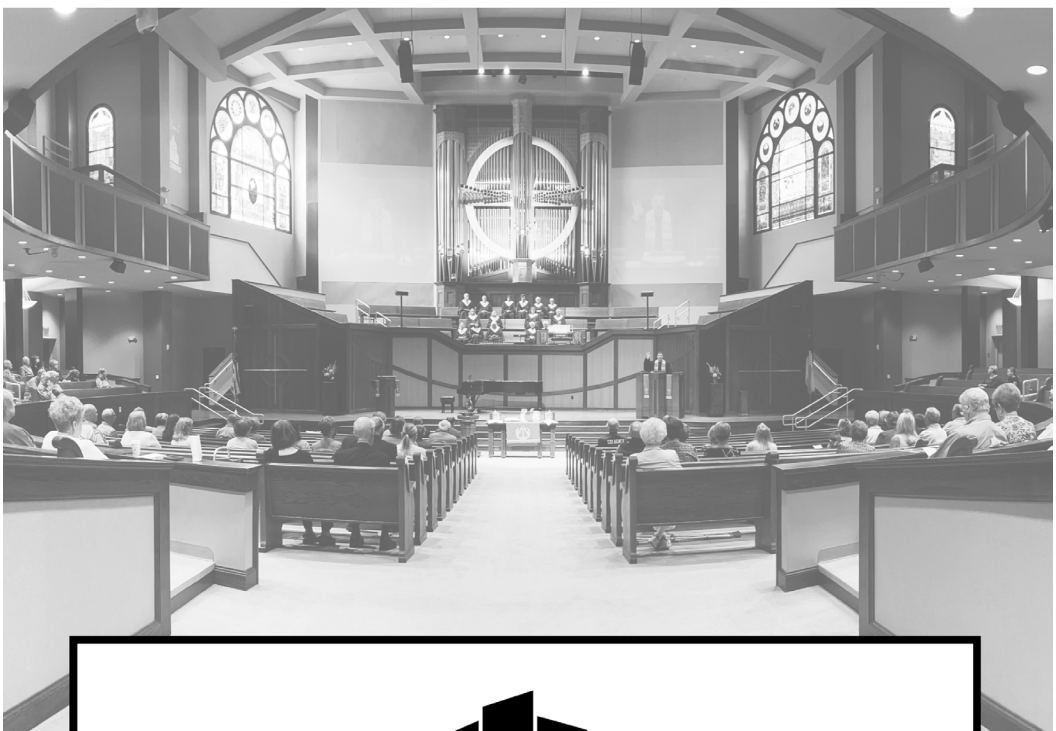

## WORLD COMMUNION SUNDAY

World Communion Sunday began in 1933 at Shadyside Presbyterian Church in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, as an initiative by Rev. Hugh Thompson Kerr to emphasize the interconnectedness of all Christian churches and highlight the unity in Christ through Holy Communion. Now celebrated globally on the first Sunday of October, this day celebrates the unity and diversity of the universal Christian community. World Communion Sunday has become a time when Christians in every culture break bread and pour the cup to remember and affirm Christ as the Head of the Church. On this day, we remember that we are part of the whole body of believers.
