# Foundational Scriptures

### **JOEL 21:15-19**

**15** Blow the [a]trumpet in Zion, Consecrate a fast, Call a sacred assembly;

16 Gather the people,
Sanctify the congregation,
Assemble the elders,
Gather the children and nursing babes;
Let the bridegroom go out from his chamber,
And the bride from her dressing room.

**17** Let the priests, who minister to the Lord, Weep between the porch and the altar; Let them say, "Spare Your people, O Lord, And do not give Your heritage to reproach, That the nations should [b]rule over them. Why should they say among the peoples, 'Where is their God?' "

18 Then the Lord will be zealous for His land, And pity His people.

19 The Lord will answer and say to His people, "Behold, I will send you grain and new wine and oil, And you will be satisfied by them; I will no longer make you a reproach among the nations.

# Fasting & Prayer Guidelines

# **BEFORE THE FAST (BODY & SPIRIT)**

- Begin to reduce your food portions prior to the fast.
- Flush the body by drinking plenty of water.
- Begin to eliminate caffeinated and sweet beverages.
- Be strategic, plan your meals ahead of time.
- Remove temptations like; snacks, candy & sodas.
- Avoid fast foods and over processed foods from your diet.

### SPIRITUAL PREPARATION:

- Read and meditate on Psalm 51 daily.
- Reduce distractions and designate a quiet time and place to be with the Lord and for reading the Bible daily.

# SUGGESTIONS DURING THE FAST

• Get a journal/notebook: Write down your prayer requests and answers and journal what the Lord says to you.

## **ESTABLISH ACCOUNTABILITY:**

• Partner with others. Pray, share, and commit to the fast with each other and hold one another accountable.

### PRAY IN SILENCE AND SOLITUDE

- Spend time in silence and solitude to allow God to speak to you.
- Limit social networking: Facebook, Twitter and Instagram.
- Limit unnecessary phone use and excessive texting.

Relevant reading: Matt. 4:1, 14:23, Mark 1:35, Luke 4:42, Ps. 46:10

### **FASTING INSTRUCTIONS:**

- Eat plenty of fruit and vegetables.
- Drink plenty of water and 100% juice.
- Eliminate or limit bread, pasta, and rice.
- Eliminate or limit meat intake to one serving a day; chicken, turkey, or fish.
- Eliminate sugar, sweets, caffeine, and snack foods; candy cake, chips, coffee, soda, etc.

### FOOD & BEVERAGE ITEMS TO INCLUDE DURING THE FAST

- All Fruits
- All Vegetables
- All Whole Grains
- All Nuts & Seeds
- All Legumes
- All Quality Oils
- Spring and distilled water, soy, almond or oat milk.

# SUGGESTIONS AFTER THE FAST

Gradually return to your regular diet. Be careful and continue to drink plenty of water and eat healthily.


