
### *A Note from Pastor Phillips:*

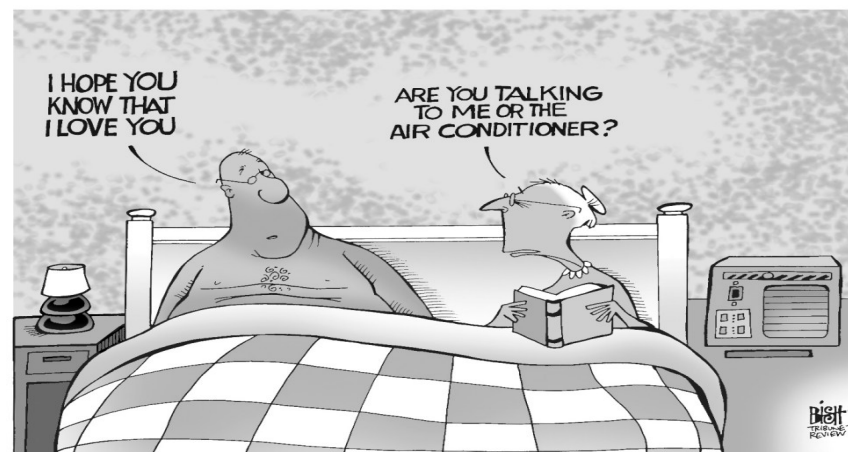
