



This 2-day experience guides Christ-followers to make disciples that make disciple-makers!


SENIOR COFFEE



Little Lights Choir is available for children ages 3 through Kindergarten and presents a Christmas program each year.


Salt Shakers Choir includes children in grades 1 through 5 and presents a Christmas program each year.
