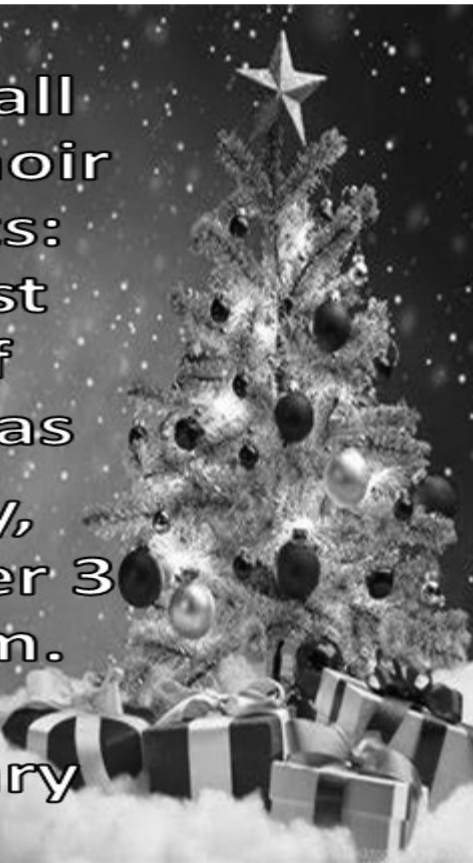
### HONORING RICK
