






## **Manna Men's Breakfast Group**

I will also be working with the Waorani people & their church & all that may entail. I am excited to see the Lord work in these ministries & many more during my time in Ecuador.

The one thing that I am asking of y'all is that you would keep me & the people of Ecuador in your prayers that they would be receptive to the gospel & that I will be a light to this dark & dying world.
