Thursday: SPACE RALLY NIGHT

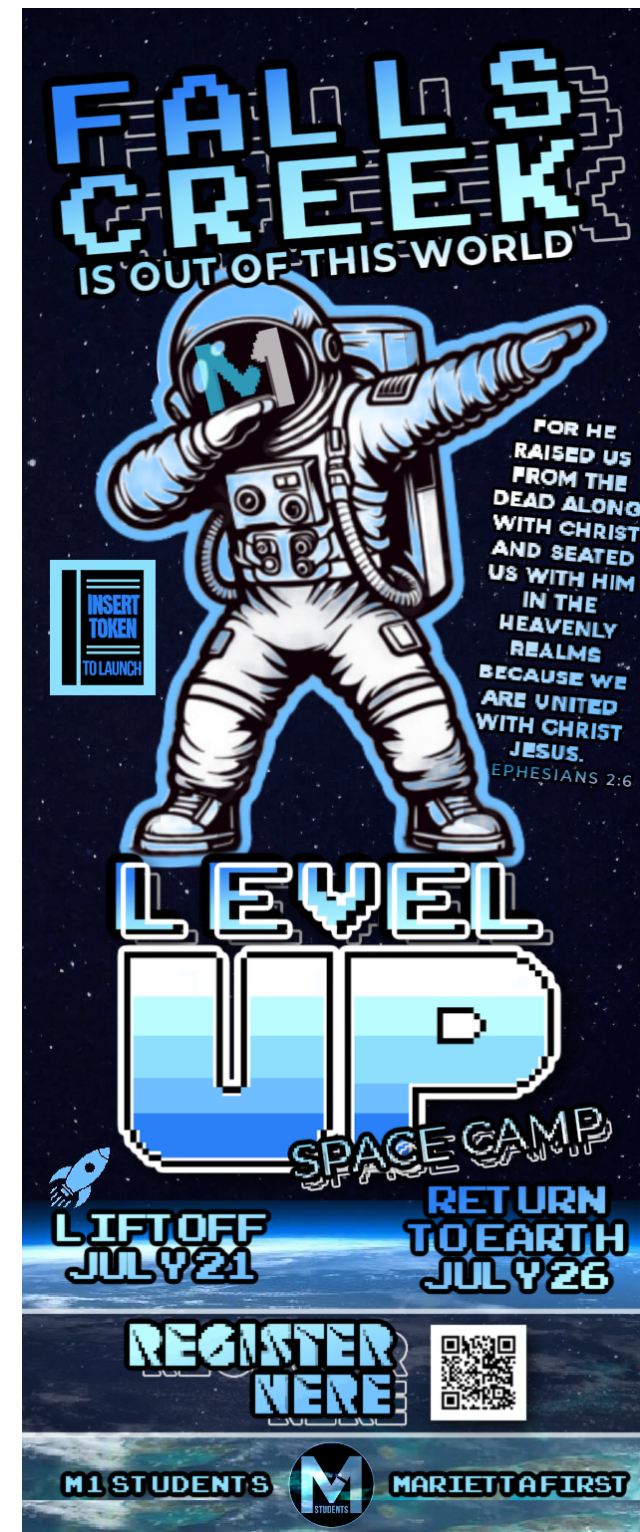
This is the tribe rally with a space theme. Dress in your planet colors (aka tribe colors): clothing, head gear, face paint, etc. Tribes announced week before camp.

- Towels
- Hygiene Products & Sunscreen
- Money for Concessions & Gift Shop Merch

- Medications (Must be given to a sponsor for safe-keeping.)

18 YEAR OLD+ STUDENTS

All students who will be at least 18 years of age by the last day of Falls Creek of July 26 are required to do a **BACKGROUND CHECK**. These students need to register by **July 13**, so we will have time to process the background check.

SPONSORS & CONTACT INFO

Students will be led and cared for by trusted adult sponsors from our church throughout the week of camp. It is a mandatory policy for Falls Creek and our church to perform a background check on every person attending Falls Creek of 18 years of age and older, including adults and students.

The lead sponsor and Student Pastor, Shane Norton, will be the primary contact person. He can be reached at (580) 276-0200. If you have an emergency and happen to not be able to reach us, please call the Falls Creek main offices at (580) 369-2101, and they will notify our cabin asap.

BAG & LUGGAGE CHECK

For the safety of everyone, there will be a luggage and bag check as students check in for Falls Creek on the Monday we leave. This will be a standard procedure for all overnight trips. Please bring your luggage and bags in the youth building with you for the initial check-in.

CHECK-IN INFO & LEAVE TIMES

- **Arrive** at the youth room at **10:00am** Monday, July 26.
- An **adult must be present** with the student to check in.
- Have all possessions in **1 suitcase & 1 "carry-on" bag**. Pillow can be a separate. **Bag checks at check-in.**
- Place **medication(s)** in a clear ziplock bag with the student's name on it prior to arrival. All medication must be in the original container from the pharmacy, and all medication must be signed in by a parent or guardian before leaving for camp.
- Ensure that **registration & payment** has been completed prior to arrival at the church.
- Eat **lunch** before you arrive or bring your lunch. Students will not be fed until Monday evening dinner.
- We **LEAVE** the church at **11:00am**.

DRESS CODE

- Shoes must be worn at all times outside of your cabin.
- Apparel may not display or promote tobacco, alcohol, controlled substances, or inappropriate language or pictures.
- Under garments must always be covered by outer garments (i.e. No boxer shorts hanging out or bra straps showing).
- Midriffs should always be covered.
- No spaghetti strap shirts or dresses.
- No tank tops.
- No short shorts. At a minimum, shorts must extend to, or just beyond, the campers' finger tips.
- No tight fitting and revealing clothing. This includes leggings or similar attire, which cannot be worn as pants.
- Girls may wear dresses/skirts, but they must reach the top of the knee.

SWIMMING:

- Girls should wear modest one-piece swim suits. Males should not wear tight fitting swimming suits.
- While going to and from the swimming areas, all campers must wear shoes. Males must wear a t-shirt and females must wear a long covering over their swimming suits.

CELL PHONE POLICY

Students will be allowed to use their cell phones during the free time each day from 1:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m. The phones can be used in the cabin's main downstairs gathering room and outside. Students are to turn off and turn in their cell phones each evening at dinner time. Their phones will be returned to them each day at lunch. One designated adult leader will be responsible for the phones that will be kept in a locked room. A checklist of each student and phone will be made by this adult for phone check in each evening. Please remember to turn off your phones before handing them in. With the exception of an emergency, students are NOT allowed to use cell phones any other time. If any student is caught with his or her cell phone outside of this designated free time, the phone will be taken. All phones that are taken will NOT be returned until the Saturday we leave.
