

REV WKND is a student ministry event for **7th-12th grade students** with the core purpose of bringing students into a deeper relationship with Christ in a fun and meaningful way. Students stay two nights at trusted church member homes where they participate in small group activities, Bible study, and relationship building. Most of the adult leaders come from our own church family, making this a memorable church-wide event. Jesus-focused worship is held at the church throughout the weekend with speaker, Dusty Bratzler, and worship leader, Reed Stout.

- **SCHOLARSHIP:** Financial help is available for those who absolutely need it. The online registration form includes a section to apply for a scholarship.

- Snacks & 2 Liter Drink
- Bible, Journal/Notepad & Pen/Pencil
- Casual Clothes & PJ's
- Recreational Clothes
- Underwear & Socks
- Sleeping Bag, Bedding & Pillow
- Towels
- Hygiene Products
- Medications *Must be given to home adults for safe-keeping.*

DO NOT PACK IT

- Knives/Weapons
- Vaping Devices, Juuls, Alcohol, Drugs, Medical Marijuana, Tobacco Products
- Lighters, Fireworks

There is a ZERO TOLERANCE policy for these items. If a student is caught one time with any of these, they can be sent home.

HOMES



An essential part of REV WKND is the time spent in the homes. Students stay two nights in homes of trusted families from our church across the area, along with leaders who invest in the students and lead small group discussion throughout the weekend. Each home is equipped and prepared to lead and take care of your child for the weekend. The students will be divided into homes and small groups based on grades and gender to discuss the topics taught in large group sessions. All house "parents" and leaders go through a background check process.

FRIDAY STUDENT CHECK-IN

REV WKND check-in is 4:30-5:30pm on Friday, February 6th at the M1 Students Building. Please enter the south door of the student building to check in. If a parent cannot accompany their child, please be sure to make sure another adult is present to check-in the student.

LUGGAGE/BAG CHECK

For the safety of everyone, there will be a luggage/bag check as students check in to REV WKND on Friday. This is a standard procedure for all overnight church trips. Please bring your luggage and bags with you through the south door of the student building for the initial check-in.

TRANSPORTATION

Students who drive to the event will be asked to leave their vehicles either at home or church for the weekend. Each home will have leaders in place to transport students. If a student needs transportation, please arrange that ahead of time. Parents of students participating in school activities or games any during the weekend are responsible for driving their children to & from the activities or arranging for a parent to drive a group of students.

NON-NEGOTIABLE CONDUCT

If a student breaks any of the following non-negotiable prohibitions, they may be sent home.

- Students will not be permitted to leave the property of their host home or the church on their own at any time during the weekend, unless given parental or sponsor permission. If a child does need to leave for any reason, parents must notify Shane Norton.
- Use or possession of illegal drugs, alcohol, tobacco products, vapes, and medical marijuana is not permitted in any form at REV WKND.
- Student possession of offensive weapons of any sort is not permitted at REV WKND.

Intentional humiliation of other students including initiation, hazing, pranks, violence or abuse could result in a camper going home upon evaluation of the situation by church leadership.
