Minister Christopher Swain born June 12, 1996, in Detroit MI, to Gregory Swain and the late Donna Brown. Minister Swain grew up at the Oak Park Missionary Baptist Church where his grandfather the late Rev Charles W. Swain, Jr. was the founder and served as Pastor up until his death in October 2013. It was at Oak Park Baptist Church where Minister Swain played the drums, sung in the youth choir, ushered and served as a trustee. Minster Swain was baptized by his Uncle Deacon Ronald swain in February 2015 at the age of 18.

In 2021, Minister Swain was appointed the Spiritual Advisor for the Truthseekers Campus Ministry at Michigan State University. Minster Swain joined the Greater Christ Baptist Church in Detroit under the leadership of the Rev. Dr. Micah R. Gaines. Minister Swain accepted his call to preach in April of 2024. He gave his initial sermon "Wait It Out" on November 17, 2024, and was licensed in the Gospel Ministry. He now serves as an Associate Minister and Young Adult Minister at Greater Christ Baptist Church. In the fall Minister Swain will be attending Virginia Union University to pursue a Master of Divinity.


