RESPONSIVE SCRIPTURE READING

James 2:1-13

Leader: My brothers and sisters, do not show favoritism as you hold on to the faith in our glorious Lord Jesus Christ.

Congregation: ² For if someone comes into your meeting wearing a gold ring and dressed in fine clothes, and a poor person dressed in filthy clothes also comes in,

Leader: ³ if you look with favor on the one wearing the fine clothes and say, "Sit here in a good place," and yet you say to the poor person, "Stand over there," or "Sit here on the floor by my footstool," ⁴ haven't you made distinctions among yourselves and become judges with evil thoughts?

Congregation: ⁵ Listen, my dear brothers and sisters: Didn't God choose the poor in this world to be rich in faith and heirs of the kingdom that he has promised to those who love him?

Leader: ⁶ Yet you have dishonored the poor. Don't the rich oppress you and drag you into court? ⁷ Don't they blaspheme the good name that was invoked over you?

Congregation: 8 Indeed, if you fulfill the royal law prescribed in the Scripture, **Love your neighbor as yourself**, you are doing well.

Leader: ⁹ If, however, you show favoritism, you commit sin and are convicted by the law as transgressors.

Congregation: ¹⁰ For whoever keeps the entire law, and yet stumbles at one point, is guilty of breaking it all.

<u>Leader</u>: ¹¹ For he who said, **Do not commit adultery**, also said, **Do not murder.** So if you do not commit adultery, but you murder, you are a lawbreaker.

All: ¹² Speak and act as those who are to be judged by the law of freedom. ¹³ For judgment is without mercy to the one who has not shown mercy. Mercy triumphs over judgment.


