1. Thanksgiving:

- Take a few moments to thank God for his faithfulness and who He is in your life.
 1. Cross and salvation
 2. Holy Spirit walking with you every day
 3. Family

- Take some time to thank God for his faithfulness to us as a church:
 1. God's faithfulness in leading us, loving, us, his consistent presence.
 2. God's faithfulness in providing all of our financial needs.

 4. Open doors to minister to our community, specifically at Bernard, the Truck.
 5. Alpha, where many people came closer to God last year.
 6. Small groups and leaders who are pouring out into the lives of others.

 8. Response of people to the preached Word.
 9. Our impact in missions around the world.

2. Personal Confession & Repentance:

- Take a few moments to examine your heart. Tell God that you desire a soft, humble heart.
- Ask the Holy Spirit to reveal anything that is not right in you: an attitude, motive, offense, words you have spoken, wrong response to someone, pride, etc. Listen to anything the Holy Spirit would say to you.
- Repent and ask God to forgive you.
- Ask to be clothed in his righteousness and for the power of the Holy Spirit to live a righteous, holy life.
