- 2 Timothy 3:1, NLT You should know this, Timothy, that in the last days there will be very difficult times.
- 2 Timothy 3:2, NLT For people will love only themselves and their money. They will be boastful and proud, scoffing at God, disobedient to their parents, and ungrateful. They will consider nothing sacred.
