Mark 13:3, NLT

Later, Jesus sat on the Mount of Olives across the valley from the Temple. Peter, James, John, and Andrew came to him privately and asked him, “Tell us, when will all this happen? What sign will show us that these things are about to be fulfilled?”

1. Israel

- Israel is regathered twice (Isaiah 11:11-12)

Isaiah 11:11, TLB

At that time the Lord will bring back a remnant of his people for the second time, returning them to the land of Israel from Assyria, Upper and Lower Egypt, Ethiopia, Elam, Babylonia, Hamath, and all the distant coastal lands.

Isaiah 11:12, TLB

He will raise a flag among the nations for them to rally to; he will gather the scattered Israelites from the ends of the earth.

Isaiah 66:7-8, TLB

Who has heard or seen anything as strange as this? For in one day, suddenly, a nation, Israel, shall be born, even before the birth pains come. In a moment, just as Israel's anguish starts, the baby is born; the nation begins.

- Israel is regathered twice (Isaiah 11:10-12)
- Israel is born in a day (Isaiah 66:8-10)
- Jerusalem is retaken by the Jews
- (Luke 21:20-24)

Luke 21:24, NLT

And Jerusalem will be trampled down by the Gentiles until the period of the Gentiles comes to an end.

- Israel is regathered twice (Isaiah 11:10-12)
- Israel is born in a day (Isaiah 66:8-10)
- Jerusalem is retaken by the Jews (Luke 21:20-24)
- The land of Israel divided and antisemitism increased (Joel 3:1-2)

Joel 3:1, NIV

In those days, and at that time, when I restore the fortunes of Judah and Jerusalem,

Joel 3:2, NIV

I will gather all nations and bring them down to the Valley of Jehoshaphat. There I will put them on trial for what they did to my inheritance, my people Israel, because they scattered my people among the nations and divided up my land.

Mark 13:28, NLT

“Now learn a lesson from the fig tree. When its branches bud and its leaves begin to sprout, you know that summer is near.

In the same way, when you see all these things taking place, you can know that his return is very near, right at the door.

3. Immorality

2 Timothy 3:1, NLT

You should know this, Timothy, that in the last days there will be very difficult times.

2 Timothy 3:2, NLT

For people will love only themselves and their money. They will be boastful and proud, scoffing at God, disobedient to their parents, and ungrateful. They will consider nothing sacred.

2 Timothy 3:3, NLT

They will be unloving and unforgiving; they will slander others and have no self-control. They will be cruel and hate what is good.

2 Timothy 3:4, NLT

They will betray their friends, be reckless, be puffed up with pride, and love pleasure rather than God.

2 Timothy 3:5, NLT

They will act religious, but they will reject the power that could make them godly.

“However, no one knows the day or hour when these things will happen, not even the angels in heaven or the Son himself. Only the Father knows. And since you don’t know when that time will come, be on guard! Stay alert!

Mark 13:34, NLT

“The coming of the Son of Man can be illustrated by the story of a man going on a long trip. When he left home, he gave each of his slaves instructions about the work they were to do, and he told the gatekeeper to watch for his return.

Mark 13:35, NLT

You, too, must keep watch! For you don’t know when the master of the household will return—in the evening, at midnight, before dawn, or at daybreak.

Mark 13:36-37, NLT

Don’t let him find you sleeping when he arrives without warning. I say to you what I say to everyone: Watch for him!”
