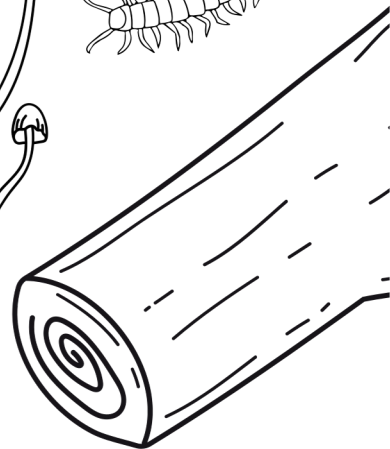
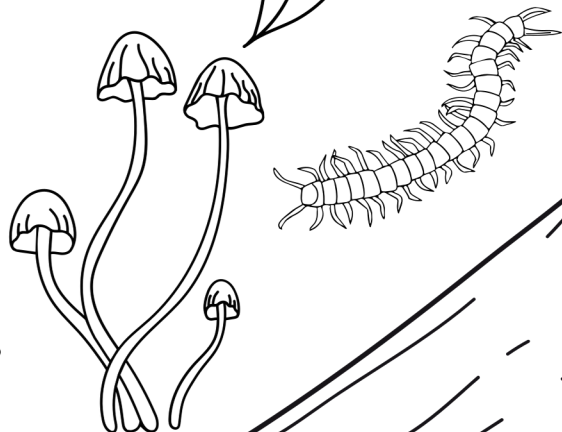
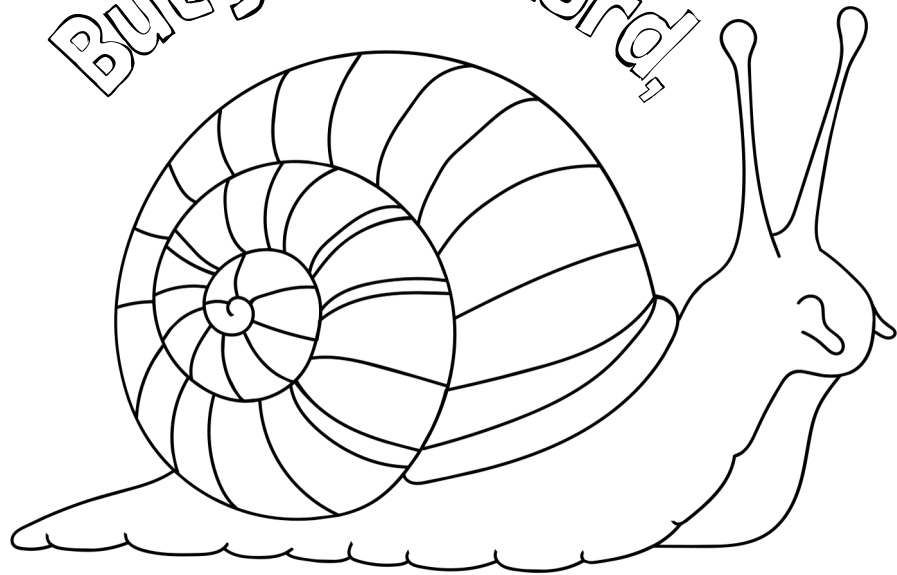
Maze Challenge
