# OBCS Enrichment Course Descriptions

*These descriptions highlight both past and present classes. Please note that not all classes listed are available this session.*

## **Artistic Creations**

Students will explore their creative gifts and deepen their understanding of Scripture through art and poetry. They will create a personalized portfolio based on seven biblical concepts, using their creativity to glorify God and grow in His Word.

## **Baking Club**

Learn the basics of measuring ingredients and following simple recipes. This course offers students hands-on experiences preparing a variety of dishes and, best of all, enjoy eating what they create!

## **Beginning Music**

This class introduces students to basic music concepts such as beat, rhythm, and notes. Through fun activities and instruments such as boomwhackers and bells, students will experience the joy of making music while building a strong foundation in musical skills.

## **Bible Study**

Explore Scripture in a supportive and engaging environment. Through discussions, activities, and reflection, students will deepen their faith and understanding of God's Word. This program is free of charge and provides an opportunity for spiritual growth and connection.

## **Cheer Team**

Students are invited to learn the fundamentals of cheerleading, including routines and sideline cheers, with performance opportunities. This program is a fun way to build confidence, teamwork, and school spirit! A required uniform fee applies.

## **Clay**

Explore the fundamentals of hand-building and sculpting with clay. Students will create both functional and decorative pieces while learning techniques such as coil, slab, and pinch methods. This course fosters creativity, patience, and craftsmanship, with opportunities for showcasing work at school and local art events.

## **Cooking**

Learn the basics of measuring ingredients and following simple recipes. This course offers students hands-on experiences preparing a variety of dishes and, best of all, enjoy eating what they create!

## **Creator's Workshop**

Student and instructor-led projects offered in a workshop style to prepare entries for the LA County Fair. This hands-on class offers the exciting opportunity for students to see their work displayed at the fair in May!

## **Cross Country – Coed Competitive Team**

Compete against other private schools throughout the Inland Empire. Tryouts will be held in the spring, and selected athletes will participate in races and events, with travel required for away meets. This program focuses on developing speed, endurance, and athleticism in a competitive setting.

## **Firm Foundations: Math Skills for Future Success**

Designed for students in grades 3-4 to support the building of a strong math foundation. The program focuses on key concepts such as place value, fact families, patterns, and fractions to ensure students develop essential skills for future success in math. Through engaging lessons, students will strengthen their understanding and confidence in foundational math topics.

## **Flag Football – Coed Competitive Team**

Represent your school in competitive flag football games against other private schools across the region. Tryouts will be held in the fall, and selected players will practice regularly and travel for away games. The program emphasizes strategy, teamwork, agility, and sportsmanship.

# OBCS Enrichment Course Descriptions

## **Guitar**

Students will learn the fundamentals of playing guitar, including basic chords and strumming techniques. Students are required to bring their own instrument on practice days to fully engage in the lessons and develop their skills.

## **Math Club Homework Help**

Need extra support with math? This club provides a focused and supportive environment where students can receive help with homework, review key concepts, and strengthen their math skills. Led by experienced instructors, the sessions offer personalized guidance to build confidence and improve understanding. Perfect for students looking to stay on track and excel in math!

## **OBCS Worship Team**

Join a team of passionate students who lead worship during chapel services and special school events. This program emphasizes musical excellence, teamwork, and spiritual leadership while representing OBCS through praise and worship. Students will grow in both skill and heart as they serve the school community together.

## **Robotics & Coding**

design, build, and program robots with an emphasis on teamwork, problem-solving, and innovation through real-world applications of coding, engineering, and design. During competitive season, compete against other schools through the FIRST Lego League Challenge event. Tryouts may be required. Travel is expected for some competitions.

## **Soccer - Competitive**

Offers students the opportunity to compete against other private school teams in the Inland Empire. Tryouts are required, and selected players will need to travel for away games. This program focuses on skill development, teamwork, and competition at a higher level.

## **Soccer - Recreational**

Designed to introduce young students to the basics of soccer in a fun and supportive environment. Through skill-building activities and friendly games, children will develop a love for the sport while learning teamwork, coordination, and basic soccer techniques.

## **Softball - Coed Competitive Team**

Compete on a coed softball team playing against private schools throughout the Inland Empire. Tryouts will be held in the spring, with selected athletes participating in games both at home and away. The team focuses on developing batting, fielding, and teamwork skills in a competitive and encouraging environment.

## **STEAM**

Dive into the world of Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Math with hands-on projects in robotics, coding, and design! Designed for 4th to 7th graders, this program encourages creativity, problem-solving, and critical thinking through interactive experiments, engineering challenges, and collaborative tech-based activities. Students will build, code, and innovate in a fun and engaging environment.

## **Track - Competitive**

Compete against other private schools throughout the Inland Empire. Tryouts will be held in Spring and selected athletes will participate in races and events, with travel required for away meets. This program focuses on developing speed, endurance, and athleticism in a competitive setting.

## **Track - Recreational**

Designed for students looking to build speed, endurance, and athleticism in a fun and supportive environment. This non-competitive program focuses on skill development, fitness, and personal improvement without the pressure of competition. Athletes will participate in structured training sessions and practice races, fostering teamwork and a love for running. No travel or tryouts required.

# OBCS Enrichment Course Descriptions

## **Welcome to Bootcamp: A Math Skills Intensive**

Designed for students in grades 5–7 who need to strengthen their math skills. This course provides a focused, hands-on approach to key topics such as fractions, decimals, percentages, and problem-solving strategies.
